Suddenly, the necklace that Nanna got from her mom starts to burn like a fire, the world disappears, and when she wakes up, Nanna finds herself at a completely different Eketorp. The ground is covered in snow, and she sees strange people in old fashioned clothes.

Soon, Nanna is given a dangerous mission which she must complete to be allowed to return home again – and to ensure that she even has a home to return to! The powerful god Lodur is threatening not only to devastate this world, but also the world that Nanna considers her own.

BOOK 2 - THE LOST MEMORY

It's summer holiday and the weather are getting warmer for each day. Nanna realizes that something must be wrong in the other world.

Time and again she goes to Eketorp, but it seems impossible to get back to Halvar's world. During a swimming trip with her best friend Lilly, she suddenly feels like she's going to drown, and when she finally makes it to the surface, she's back with Halvar.

It's urgent, he says. They must take a boat to the north of Öland to find the third goddess of fate and make her remember who she is. Only with her help can they defeat the terrible Lodur.
