As an author, Mats has always been inspired by movies and television, which is evident in his way of building characters, telling stories and writing dialogue. Therefore, it is no surprise that his fiction is so well suited to being adapted into just that.

With more than 25 years in the industry, Malin is one of Sweden's most experienced and versatile screenwriters, with a wide range of genres and formats on her resume. Her body of work contains drama, comedy, crime, children and horror - a width that is not just a reflection of her talent but also of her experience.

Malin debuted in 1999 with Vägen ut, which earned her a nomination for best screenplay at Guldbaggegalan

The two sisters started working together in 2019, and since then their production rate has been impressing, writing as well tv-series, feature films and theatre.

Their trademark is to blend humour with heart felt drama, with a detailed eye for pop culture references, and an ability to never let go of the most central thing; their characters. Tove and Sofie like to write in several genres and for different audiences, something that is apparent if you look at their resume.

JIMMY NIVRÉN OLSSON

Jimmy wants to win hearts rather than awards, an approach that has led him to succeed with both. His big breakthrough came with UFO Sweden, which was nominated for the audience award at Guldbaggegalan 2023. A Spielberg-esque film with a very Swedish tone, which showcases Jimmy as a writer, with its warm humour, strong characters, and well-crafted plot.

In addition to writing genre, Jimmy's speciality lies in crime and suspense. Early in his career, he worked under Björn Carlström at Harmonica, developing multiple crime projects, which was a perfect school for mastering the craft of writing for tv. It also led him to co-writing two episodes of the hit show Jägarna (The Hunters).

Jimmy is currently developing a major Swedish crime IP for television, and is a perfect writer to hire for suspense, thriller and crime projects.

In 2023, the first show with her as a main writer (Live Life) premiered. Season two is set to premiere in 2025.

Karin is also a book author, that specializes in domestic noir. Her latest novel, Little Darling, was released in January 2025. It is a pshycological thriller about a parent's worst nightmare.

Apart from writing, Christoffer has worked a lot as a director, which has shaped his way of writing: he is good at transforming an idea of a scene into text, which makes for very compelling manuscripts.

When it comes to genre, audience and format, Christoffer likes to vary. The most important thing for him is to capture the everyday human experience, no matter the story. He is drawn to writing about outsiders that feel as if they are not enough for the world they live in.

Christoffer often work together with Thobias Hoffmén. Their different personalities and strenghts complement each other in a way that reflect in the stories they write... and they have a lot of fun doing it.

The award winning film So Damn Easy Going, that we wrote and directed, opened Gothenburg International Film Festival in 2022.

Thobias Hoffmén can write for big audiences as well as for a narrower crowd, and this range is one of his absolute strengths. The biggest drive for him is to use this strength and create niche films for a wide audience. Stories with a strong dramatic core but unpredictable genre twists and associations that make them memorable.

When it comes to form of work, Thobias doesn't mind going from being the main writer to a writer's room, or working as dramatic coach or script consultant as he has done for multiple productions.

His most frequent collaboration partner is Christoffer Sandler.

When it released in 2022. Håkan Bråkan became the most visited domestic film in Swedish cinemas since 2019. The third film in the trilogy will be released in 2025.

Being human is hard ... but what better way to deal with it than through laughter? Marja Nyberg's speciality lies in exploring human behaviour through comedy. She does this by identifying her character's everyday issues and finding the comic angle in their struggle.

Marja's started at the radio, where she wrote on several sketch programs at P3. This led to the request of test writing an episode for the popular tv-show Partaj. The episode was accepted, and since then, Marja has become a specialist in writing sitcoms, working with productions like Fullt hus and Sommaren med släkten. In 2022, she wrote two episodes for FLX's hit show Solsidan, a dream job for any comedy writer in Sweden.

Emmy Abrahamson writes female driven comedy and drama, for tv and film as well as novels, for both adults and teenagers.

Emmy is passionate about female-driven comedy-dramas, comedies and sitcoms, and is currently developing several original ideas for both film and television. At some point she might also develop a TV-series about a woman called Aurora who keeps getting kidnapped.

Emmy is also an author of feel-good books, and has been sold to over 20 countries. Two of her novels are currently in development for the screen.

Theo is drawn to cinematic, suspenseful stories across several genres, but always with a big heart and more profound questions at the core. He's determined to tell emotional and enduring stories that audiences want to discuss, dissect and revisit several times after they've experienced them. Parallell with developing his own ideas, Theo works as a script consultant for tv-series and feature films. A name for the future!

In the fall of 2024, Theo's script Wetiko was selected for The Black List's writer's lab in LA, among 1700 submissions. The film has been picked up by an international producer, who are developing it together with Theo.

Aida Wondimu began her career as an editor at UR, where her work on the talk show Tänk till earned a Kristallen nomination for Best Innovator in 2021. She then went on to study screenwriting at SKH, where she wrote an episode of the hit series Solsidan for her graduation. The script impressed FLX, who not only produced the episode but also hired Aida. Over two years at FLX, she wrote 15 episodes of Solsidan and contributed to four episodes of Snödrömmar, the 2024 Christmas calendar.'

Currently, Aida is studying screenwriting at Alma Löv while looking for opportunities as an episode writer. With her specialty in comedy and drama, Aida is a promising talent ready to contribute her sharp storytelling to new projects.

ROBIN SHERLOCK HOLM

From a young age, Robin started working on big productions like Johan Falk & Gåsmamman, trying more or less every position behind the camera. These experiences gave him the confidence and know-how to make his debut film, Ticket Holders, which was prized at the IndieFEST Film Awards 2018. Robin was only 18 when he wrote and directed it.

When it comes genre, Robin likes to vary, but his strength lies in creating suspense and relational drama. A great showcase of this is Avgrunden (The Abyss), a disaster thriller produced by SF Studios for Netflix. It is as much a film about a crack in the ground as a rift in a family, and this layered storytelling is exactly what Robin aims to achieve.

Robin created the idea and co-wrote the script for Avgrunden (The Abyss), which has been streamed by more than 50 million viewers on Netflix.

Astrid Mohlin specializes in humour, young adult, and drama. Her trademarks are character driven stories with a witty yet realistic dialogue. Astrid has written, directed and produced several shows for SR, like their Christmas calendar from 2023, and premiered as a tv-writer on FLX's hit show Solsidan, also in 2023.

Early in her career, Astrid was at Nickelodeon, which taught her a lot about writing for kids. She then moved SR, before going freelance. Now, her tone lies somewhere between the goofy and crazy at Nickelodeon and the more classical storytelling at SR.

Astrid's podcast series Fake (SR) was a big hit, so much so that it comes out as a book in the spring of 2024, published by Bonnier Carlsen.







GUSTAV TEGBY

Gustav Tegby is a screenwriter, author and playwright with a fondness for everything that's weird, supernatural and noir-ish. He has written more than thirty plays, that have been performed in Sweden, Finland and the US, and he has written four popular books for children.

The last years, Gustav has gravitated more towards tv and film, both on his own and together with others, like Tove & Sofie Forsman. He is currently writing on a historical drama feature for a streaming service.

Gustav has also worked a lot with radio. He was one of the writers of the hit thriller mockumentary Voices of the Dead (De dödas röster), and one of the creators and writers of the 2017 radio Christmas series A Winter Nightmare (Marvinter).

In 2022, Gustav's book Army of Orphans was nominated for the Swedish Crimetime Award, in the Young Adult category.

For almost thirty years, Johan Bogaeus has written film and tv scripts. He writes in all genres, from crime to christmas calenders, and work with selfinitated projects as well as ones that are presented to him. It is the quality of the individual project that matter: what the context around it looks like and what story is about to be told.

Is there a common thread in the stories that Johan Bogaeus write? Well, they are often about a character's attempt to become true to, and stand up for, themselves. What this means is that the protagonist will face strong reactions from the people around them, either as supportive figures or obstacles. If you succeed in creating engaging characters with significant relationships, then you are well on your way to a good film story, and this is Johan Bogaeus signature.

Johan has written four films in the popular crime series about Martin Beck (Deadlock, Rage Room, Undercover, The Devils Advocate).

The recognition of both Torkel Petterson in the leading role and Ahmed Bozan in a supporting role highlights Björn's remarkable skill in character direction.



Sara spent her 20's attaining a degree in Film Studies, while working as a screenwriter and script consultant. At 30 she signed the contract for her debut novel - The Circle - which she co-wrote with Mats Strandberg. Together they penned the bestselling and critically acclaimed Engelsfors trilogy. The Circle has been sold to 31 countries, made into a movie and was nominated to the August Award in 2011.
